Application process

Stage 1 Completed application form

This is used as an initial screening for all applicants to ensure that their experience and background match the requirements of the programme.

Stage 2 References

You need to nominate two individuals who will be asked to act as referees in order to establish your commitment to, and suitability for, the programme. We ask you to be responsible for collecting these confidential references in the envelopes provided and returning them to us.

If you wish to apply to join the programme please return the application form and references.

Stage 3 Interview

You will be invited to come to Ashridge and meet with a faculty member and possibly other prospective participants. You will have an individual interview and be introduced to the learning environment at Ashridge.

After completion of these three stages the faculty will consider your application and either offer you a place or, in the event that we feel you are not yet ready for the programme, indicate the areas in which you would need to acquire either experience or education.

Commitment and fees

We will require written acceptance of the offer within 30 days, together with a deposit of £500. This payment secures the place and will be deducted from the full programme fee. The fee for AMOC (2008-2009) is £18,500 + VAT. The fee for ADOC (2008-2012) is £28,500 + VAT.

A 10% bursary is available to independent consultants, public and voluntary sector employees.
